## **Magic Castle**

I'd be more than happy to hand out Magic Castle guest passes. The guest pass is good for up to eight people on any night except Saturday; You must be at least 21 years old. Coats and ties are required for the men and evening wear (i.e., cocktail dresses) for the ladies; Guests must have dinner; and there is an entrance charge of \$8.50 for each guest in addition to the dinner price.

Note: I am also willing to take a group of up to 8 people some night. If guests are with a member, there is no \$8.50 entrance charge and dinner is optional.

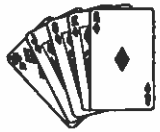

5. Magic Review

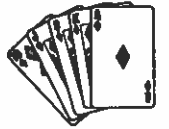
